CHANGE TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS NO: 1

The Sailing Instructions for the Autumn League 2024 are changed as follows:

6.1 Offshore Committee Vessel Starts C Course Designation

The fifth sentence is changed to read as follows:

Windward marks Z (BLACK inflatable for Cr 1 and 2 and YELLOW inflatable for Cr 3,4 and 5) will be laid approximately to windward of the starting line. These are the first marks on all fixed mark courses.

All other sections of this Sailing Instruction remain unchanged.

Appendix to Sailing Instructions


Windward/Leeward course (All marks shall be rounded to port)

S.I. 6.4 refers to the option available to the Race Committee to set a Windward/Leeward course. Should this option be chosen, Flag 'W' will be displayed on the Committee Vessel starting the race.

O 'Outer' Windward Mark W (Black)

NOTE: Offset Marks <u>will</u> be laid. These will be small Orange spherical Marks

o 'Inner' Windward Mark **W** (Yellow)



O 'Inner' Leeward Mark L (Yellow)

□ Outer' Leeward Mark L (Black)

For Inshore fleets:

Puppeteers use the **Outer** Black marks Howth 17s and Squibs use the **Inner** Yellow marks

For Offshore fleets:

Cruisers 1 and 2 use the **Outer** Black marks

Cruisers 3, J24 and Non-Spinnaker classes 4 and 5 use the **Inner** Yellow marks

The Courses to be sailed and the number of rounds will be displayed on boards on the starting committee vessel:

1: Start - W-O-L-F

2: Start - W-O-L-W-O-L-F

3: Start: -W-O-L-W-O-L-F

Description of marks:

W: Windward mark

O: Offset mark
L: Leeward mark

F: Finish
